Park Passes

All teams should have received their park passes by now – if for some reason you have not, please reach out to me as soon as possible. Everyone who enters the park is required to either have a park pass OR pay the gate fee upon arrival.

When you arrive at the park, you will take your first right and then take the first left to the festival site. Please adhere to parking signs; all festival parking will be in the field to the left of the road. Only those who require accessible parking, or who are part of the event team, are permitted to park in the gravel lot on the right. Please see the map below.

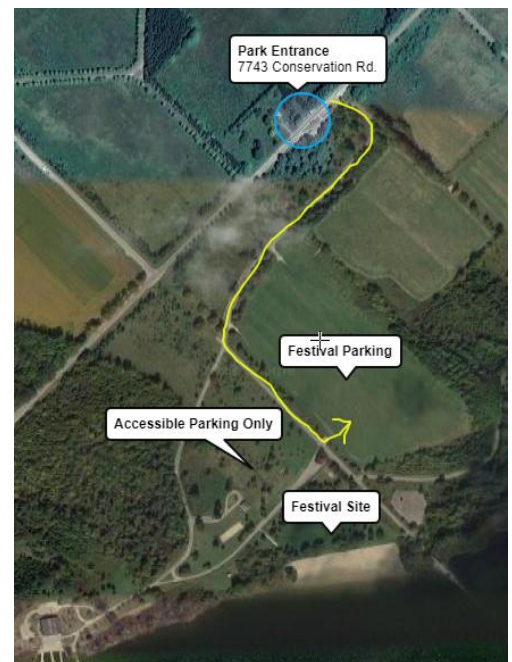
Rosters & Waivers

Race Progression & Format

There have been changes to the race progression due to scheduling conflicts. Please review the latest version attached to this email.

- 6:00am – Park gates open
- 6:45am – Registration opens
- 7:15am – Team Captain's Meeting
- 7:30am – Marshalling for first race
- 8:00am – First race

All teams are automatically registered to participate in the 2000m final and all 2000m finals will be seeded based on the time/rank of your first heat. ***If your team is NOT planning to race in the 2000m final, please email me in advance so that we can make the proper schedule changes.***
